PE kit

Pale blue, pale yellow, red or green shirts (according to child's house)

Black plimsolls - trainers are not suitable for indoor P.E.

The kit should be kept in a suitable drawstring shoe bag. Swimming - swimming hats must be worn for safety reasons.

OUTER GARMENT

1. Green waterproof coats embroidered with the school badge are available from reception.

Shoes should be sensible, and black, navy or brown. Boots and trainers should not be worn. Plain sandals may be worn in summer.

Good quality second-hand uniform is sold at many of the 'Friends of Bishop Cornish' events, and a rack of Second Time Around uniform is usually available in Reception.

If parents have any problem with school uniform please do not hesitate to contact the Head Teacher.

Optional Items

- Hair accessories, if worn, should be dark green or dark blue.
- School cap to protect the children during very hot weather - available from Reception - £3.00.

ART/CRAFT, ETC.

It is important that the children bring an apron, overall or old shirt to protect their clothes during painting, technology and science activities. These too should be clearly named.

JEWELLERY

For safety reasons we suggest that pupils should not wear jewellery to school. For pupils with pierced ears, only studs should be worn. Juniors are allowed to wear watches. Long hair should be tied back for health and safety reasons.

LOST PROPERTY

There is a 'lost treasure' chest. If clothing is marked every effort is made to return it to the owner. Un-named clothing is disposed of at the end of every term.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

Children are discouraged from bringing toys, money, games, valuable items, etc. to school except for specific reasons.
