New Year Discos - Friday 5th January

The PTA will be holding the New Year Discos in the school hall on 5th January. There will be two discos, one for Reception children and Years 1 and 2 and the second for Year 3, 4, 5 and 6. It is really important that children only attend the disco for their age group.

The **Reception and KS1** disco starts at **5.15pm** and finishes at **6.00pm.** Children will need to be collected from the hall.

The KS2 disco starts at 6.15pm and finishes promptly at 7.15pm. If children are attending this disco they must enter school through Mr Hill's classroom but they must not arrive before 6.05pm.

The staff will need to register **all** the children as they arrive in school.

All children must be picked up by an adult and no child will be allowed to leave the building unaccompanied. Only children who attend Bishop Cornish School can attend as it is not suitable for preschool children.

The entry fee is £1.00 and there will be glow sticks and disco fingers for them to purchase. There will also be fruit for sale and free access to water

If your child has never been to a disco, if you would like to stay, please do. There will be tea and coffee available outside the Year 2 classroom for parents who wish to stay but not join in the dancing!

If you are able to help preparing fruit before the disco please do let us know.
