## **Year One Activities - 5**

**Physical Activity - I can make up a dance and perform it!**

Warm up - move to one of your favourite pieces of music: eg FLASH or the Wallace and Gromit theme. Crouch down low and jump up high! Move fast/slow/stop and then move again in a different direction!

Explain that our journey today will take us to the planet Metallica and that the life form that we are going to find are robots!

Map the sequence of the dance - land your space craft on the surface of metallica (to Apollo 2 Countdown music). Open the door and step into the unknown! Discover the robots and explore how they move - think about creating a pathway to meet them and a motif of how they move (The Robots: Kraftwerk). At the end of the dance wave goodbye as you fly away.

Practise your dance several times and then share as your final performance ☺
