TOP TIPS FOR YOUR DESIGN

- 1. Your design should be bold and colourful with simple shapes making up your design-remember to keep letters and numbers big enough to read easily.
- 2. Your journey should include hops, skips, jumps, letters and number games to keep your body and mind active.
- 3. Your design should include no more than a maximum of 10 elements.
- 4. See the examples of playground designs below to inspire you; remember the theme is all about saving our planet, so accompany it with a story or poem.
- 5. Think about what your current playground has. Is there anything missing? What do you enjoy playing with? A maze, jumping, counting, hopscotch or shapes to follow? Use these in your design.
- 6. Most of all have fun. We can't wait to see your creations!
