- Making friends, sharing and taking turns
- Deciding on and learning the rules of the classroom and school
- Finding our feet around the classroom and new areas.
- Personal Hygiene including toileting and washing hands.
- Learning routines of the school day.
- Jigsaw (PSHE) meeting Jigsaw Jenie and learning about being me in my world.
- Knowing about each other- what makes us super?

Physical Development

- Awareness of space and of self.
- Group games; getting to know you, group and playground games.
- Finger gym activities
- Squiggle while you wiggle
- Getting dressed and undressed independently.
- Using a correct pencil grip and gaining control with mark making implements.
- Outside play

Understanding the World

- Everyday superhero's- visits including RNLI and firefighters.
- Thinking about what made Jesus a superhero.
- Learning about our new school areas and playing in the woods.
- Learning and noticing seasonal changes.
- Learning about Harvest and visiting Church to celebrate.

Mathematical Development

- Chanting numbers in order 1-10
- Using number names in order.
- Counting up to 5 objects.
- Finding 1 more or less than a given number up to 5.
- Using simple mathematical language to describe shapes.
- Learning different 2D shape names.
- Using shapes to make pictures and patterns.
- Using simple mathematical language to describe size.
- Knowing amounts e.g. is 5

Communication and Language

- Getting to know other children and learn each other's names.
- Listening to stories, poems and rhymes.
- Listening to each other during circle times.
- Learning new vocabulary linking to our topic such as what can you find on a farm.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Drawing - self-portrait, our families.
- New classroom areas and resources for role play and being creative.
- Painting -colours, mixing colours, mark making.
- Colour monster mixing, making our own feeling jars.

Literacy

- Starting to introduce letter sounds - RWI
