



## Hola niños

I hope you all enjoyed your half term.

This week we are learning some new Spanish words to describe different times of the day. Please see pictures above. As you can see both afternoon and evening are the same 'tarde'. Remember for the class register in the afternoon we say, 'Buenas tardes' (Good afternoon).

We are going to combine these new words with the days of the week to make sentences about the High Street.

• Eg; El lunes por la mañana voy a la cathedral.

On Monday morning I'm going to the cathedral.





• El martes por la tarde voy al supermercado.

On Tuesday afternoon/evening I'm going to the supermarket.



• El jueves por la noche voy a la tienda.

On Thursday night I'm going to the shop.

Today I would like you to draw a picture like the one below the title to show you the different times of the day in Spanish. Then I would like you to write five sentences in Spanish similar to the three examples above. Below is a reminder for the words for the days of the week.
